



WRE Bulletin #3 – WRE Sprint event Robinson Roadhouse - July 22, 2011

Map and Terrain:

Robinson Roadhouse

Scale 1:5,000

Contour interval = 2.5 metres

ISSOM (IOF Sprint) standard

Terrain is a mix of negative topography of varying complexity and low hills and ridges. The forest is a generally very open forest of pine and natural meadows. There are some slightly thicker areas of spruce trees. Larger depressions have vegetation such as willow and birch naturally associated with lower (and seasonally wet) areas. There is a fairly well developed trail network, in an irregular pattern, and a few man-made objects, such as small pits and old ruins. There are no rock or water features.

Summary of entries received:

As of June 27: 12 registered in W21; 31 registered in M21. There are at least three *ranked runners* registered in W21 and M21. A *ranked runner* is defined as one who has scored World Ranking points in the 18 months before the event **and** whose average points score is greater than or equal to 600 **and** who finishes within the winner's time plus 50%

Deviations from the rules:

None.

Special Note - IOF Competition Rule 21.4:

Competitors may not use or carry telecommunication equipment between entering the pre-start area and reaching the finish in a race, unless the equipment is approved by the organiser. GPS data loggers with no display or audible feedback can be used. The organiser may require competitors to wear a tracking device.

Transport schedule:

There is no organized transportation.

Course details:

M21: Length: 2.7 km; Climb: 53 metres; # of controls: 16
W21: Length: 2.3 km; Climb: 45 metres; # of controls: 18

There are no refreshment points on the courses.

At approximately 4/5 of the way around both courses they cross the finish chute at right angles. There will be a gap in the finish chute.

Special Symbols:

There is a black X used on both the W21 and M21 courses. It is a small debris pile.

Reserve punch boxes:

In the event of a Sport ident unit not functioning, competitors must manually punch in the reserve box printed on the map.

Control description dimensions:

M21: 5.5 cm by 14.5 cm
W21: 5.5 cm by 15.5 cm

Time limit for complaints:

30 minutes after finishing your course.

Location for making complaints:

Complaints and protests can be made at the registration tent in the arena of the event.

Maximum running time:

60 minutes.

Jury members:

The Jury will be drawn from the COC Jury pool, and chaired by the IOF Event Advisor Alex Kerr.
